SCB -186th Programme - GERIATRIC NEUROLOGY



The summer is on. It was hot outside at 10.30 am, on 19.03.16 but it was chill inside the hall of Institution of Valuers, with a good ambience. There were more than 60 participants to hear the renowned geriatrician Padmasri Dr. V. S. NATARAJAN, on the topic "GERIATRIC NEUROLOGY". The meeting commenced with important announcements followed by silent invocation. The Chairman honoured the chief guest and extended a very warm welcome to one and all. In his address the Chairman traced exemplary service rendered by Dr. VSN, as Chairman of Senior Citizens Bureau for 8 vears from 2001-02 to 2009-2010 and promotion of health oriented programs. The then Chairman Emeritus. late Maj. Gen. Aban Naidu and then Secy. Gen. Dr. Capt. M. Singaraja, convinced Dr. VSN to accept the Chairmanship in a crucial SGM held in 2001, assuring no hindrance to his normal work. They stood behind him solidly, all along. The Chairman recalled the events held at Rajah Annamalai Manram, Kumaran Hospital, Lyola College and Stella Maris College during the tenure of Dr. VSN. The Chairman paid glowing tribute to Dr. VSN for his pioneering work to the geriatric medicine in India, a rare speciality and for giving a thrust to the era of elder care. The Chairman recalled the support rendered by Dr. VSN. to all the community projects, such as Age Care sessions for the students, 6 months Geriatric Nursing Assistant training course, Geriatric Health monitoring camp, conceived and executed by him as then Secy. Gen. The Chairman underlined that Dr. VSN has got the credit of treating many elderly with bonus life which is more valuable than many awards right from B C Roy Award to PadmaSri Award. He has also authored more than 30 books. His latest book on Geriatric Neurology (முதுமையும் மூளை நரம்பு நோய்களும்), in Tamil, gives a wealth of information to the older persons and care givers alike. There is a great demand for its expected English translation.

Dr VSN in his address, narrated that elders lack awareness of neurological problems like tremor, Parkinson's disease, dementia, depression, fits, headache, coma, unsteadiness, disabilities, neuropathy, facing them. Neurological problems of the elderly are very



common. Bone and joint problems come next. It is the need of the hour to create awareness among elderly to avail the earliest medical management for the best possible relief. Many elders are under the impression that most of the neurological diseases are age related. It is a myth. They must be aware of the difference between the ageing process and diseases like Parkinson's disease, dementia, etc. It is important to consult a doctor when elders develop headache. When headache persists for more than three weeks, or is not responding to painkiller, or associated with giddiness, vomiting and visual disturbance, it is a symptom for the onset of neurological diseases in elderly. There was a rapt attention throughout his lecture for more than one hour. health tips were very well received and His appreciated. After a lively Q & A session and a vote of thanks proposed by the Secy. Gen., Thiru S. Jayakumar, all rose for National Anthem.
