In commemoration of 9th Anniversary of Geriatric House Call Project (GHCP) Senior Citizen Bureau (SCB), organized a free "Jayam Geriatric Health Screening Camp", on 19.02.17, from 10.00 am to 1.30 pm, at Jayam Poly Clinic and Nursing Home, 58, Thiruvanmiyur, Chennai-41. This is the 202nd event. Thiru G. Ramasubramanian, Manager of the nursing home welcomed the gathering. Dr. Capt. M. Singaraja, Chairman, Senior Citizens Bureau-U3A Chennai, in his inaugural address traced the history of GHCP as follows. It was launched on Feb 17, 2008, by the late founder Chairman Gen. Aban Naidu, PVSM, AVSM. It is a unique project to treat the immobile senior citizens at their doorsteps by geriatric / family physicians and paramedical staff. The concept of house visits by the Doctors has totally disappeared. Doctors refuse to make house calls due to multiple reasons. Thus the sick and immobile elderly are denied immediate medical attention at their door steps, leading to complications and danger to the life. Periodical medical care is essential to the bedridden elderly. Transportation and waiting in the clinics are major constraints to the family members of the elderly, in terms of time and money. This was a major concern and a pressing need to the then Secretary General Capt. M. Singaraja, to serve the infirm elderly. With the help of the then Chairman of SCB Dr. VS Natarajan, we initially identified a panel of doctors and paramedical professionals to visit the immobile sick elderly at their homes, in and around Kilpauk and Anna Nagar. The strength of the professionals and the pockets of service in Chennai city slowly increased. SCB brought out publications and arranged scientific sessions. Thanks to media, GHCP was gaining popularity as the first of its kind in the country. At the same time, we were confronted with many difficulties. There was lack of Government support, lack of adequate doctors, lack of dedicated call centre, statistics, documentation and transportation. There was disconnect

between the Doctors and the patients, demand for visits at odd hours, sudden calls for long neglected sick elderly, 11th hour attempt to save the patients after discharge from the hospital by the specialists. etc. However due to increasing awareness and impact of the concept of the house call visits created by SCB, there was more and more demand. Apart from the individual consultants, dedicated home service from the nursing homes and hospitals entered into the scene. The chairman Dr. Capt. M. Singaraja, commended the home services offered by Dr. Ramesh Sadasivan, Medical Director, Jayam Poly Clinic and Nursing Home with his team of Dr. Arun Kumar, Thiru G. Ramasubramanian and R.Srividya. In appreciation of such impressive service, the Chairman honored Dr. Ramesh Sadasivan, for organizing a health monitoring camp, in commemoration of 9th Anniversary of Geriatric House Call Project of SCB. Also he distributed the testimonials to 12 supporting staff, on completion of clinical training programs, conducted by TACT academy under education grant by Prasanna Medical and Educational Charitable Trust. Dr. Ramesh Sadasivan in his address explained the facilities, offered for house call visits since 3 years. He honored the SCB Chairman, after Q&A session. Brig. Muthulaxmi proposed a vote of thanks. Free tests such as, Random Blood Sugar Test by Eris, Uric Acid by Abbott, Lipid Profile by Dr. Reddy's Laboratories Ltd, ABI (Ankle Brachial Index, Non invasive measure of peripheral vascular disease) by Eris and PFT (Pulmonary Function Test with Spiro meter) by Sun Pharma Laboratories Ltd were continued after national anthem and tea. All the tests were of digital method with instantaneous results (1st time in India) by the reputed companies. The participants availed free consultation by the doctors. Nice Lunch was served. 56 persons attended. Everybody appreciated the comfort and dignity made available at the camp. ÷
