





- 2) It was decided to have next EC meeting physically on 20th March 2022 at the residence of our Secretary General.
- 3) Secretary General requested all EC members to attend with other members of SCB. Zoom AGM on 5th March 2022 and make it a grand success.
- 4) Since Draft Policy for improving the benefits of the Senior Citizens have to be submitted to Government

- of Tamil Nadu, members expressed their views and Chairman noted all point and agreed to submit the same before due date.
- 5) Since situation is improving it was decided to have our next Quarterly meeting physically in April. The venue and Chief Guest will be decided in due course. We also decided to release our quarterly SCB NEWS by April 2022
- 6) Since it was decided to have our Valedictory function of our Silver Jubilee celebrations in the month October 2022, we drafted out the plan of commencing the work immediately for successful completion of the function. With the vote of thanks by Thiru Balasubramanian the meeting came to an end.

Our Recommendations Submitted to the committee formed by Tamilnadu Government

A person's mobility and dexterity will naturally decline as they age, which makes completing everyday task more difficult. More support is needed to enable elderly people not only to live independently through products and programs which focus on safety, balance, fitness and mobility but also to ensure that they can continue to thrive as an individual. When complete Independence is no longer practical, many elderly people require additional care. Sometimes this can be provided by family members, but this can place a lot of strain on the care giver in terms of balancing with their work and family responsibilities.

Health care can be complicated and disjointed for elderly people especially for those struggling with long term conditions. Ageing comes with many challenges like loss of financial independence, diminished physical activity, age discrimination and abuse and health care.

In the above circumstances it is imperative on the part of the Governments both Central and state to formulate policies enabling Senior citizens to live a safe, healthy, active and dignified life. Taking into account all the above aspects our Senior Citizens Bureau is forwarding the following points with a request to consider them in the draft policy on Senior Citizens.

- 1. It should be made available in all government hospitals a comprehensive GERIATRIC health check up including Vaccination for pneumonia and flu at free of cost.
- 2. Training/Counseling should be given to care givers of the old people on the resources and emotional support necessary to help them deliver the best care of the loved ones and themselves.
- 3. Establishment of specialized centers (Day Care Centers) exclusively for older people like

Anganvadies. It is necessary because in many families both husband and wife are working leaving behind the older people alone at home.

- 4. Establishment of Old Age Homes in all districts and taluk headquarters.
- 5. Consider the increase of monthly pensions to old people which will take care of them independently, enabling to live with dignity.
- 6. Complaints filed by older people with the police stations/ cases filed with courts are to be attended on priority basis with time bound and monitored by district courts/ Collectors office. Separate courts to deal with the problems of Elders like elder abuse, property disputes etc.
- 7. Patrolling of houses of older people / couple who resides alone as those are Main targets of the miscreants.
- 8. Health insurance policy the premium is much higher with age. Concession on premium for older people should be considered with waiver of GST. This can be taken up with the GST council for action.
- 9. There is mushroom growth of private old age homes. Controlling on their functioning to be exercised by the GOVERNMENT including the cost of food and other amenities which can also be subsidized by the Government.

The above are some of the points which have to be considered by the Government sympathetically with commitment for the protection and welfare of the Senior Citizens.

We request you to kindly highlight these points in your policy document to the Tamil Nadu Government.
