ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE PERIOD ENDING 31.03.2014

Dear Friends,

Vanakkam. It is my proud privilege to present this Annual Report before this august body, in the AGM, being held on June 28.06.2015.

1.0 Introduction : This Bureau was registered under Societies Act on 24th Sept. 2002 with Reg. No. 370/2002. But it was founded on 3rd March 1996 and as such the Bureau steps into 20th year.

As you know that this Bureau is marching with its pioneering service to the Elders of the Society. It is worth remembering on this occasion, the valuable contributions made for the growth of the Bureau by founding fathers and the office bearers / EC Members (past and present) as well as the support extended by our members, other organisations & Govt. We have been representing vital issues and grievances concerning Senior Citizens, to the Govt. both State & Central.

2.0 Membership: With our earnest efforts for sustained development the strength is: IM (Institutional Member)-1, DM (Donor Member)-2, LM (Life Member)-331, AM (Annual Member) - 7, JSL (Journal Life Subscriber)-72 = total 414.

3.0 Meetings.

- 3.1 The last AGM was held at 12.00 p.m. on June 21, 2014,(Saturday), at Ethiraj College for Women, 70,.Ethiraj Salai, Egmore, Chennai-600 008. The minutes is read out and adopted today.
- 3.2 Commemoration of 19th Annual Day Conference, 11th year publication of "Link Age" and 9th World Elders Day Awareness was observed on 21.06.2014 at 10.30hrs, preceding the AGM.

Padmasri Dr. V.S. Natarajan, Patron / IAG & SCB, delivered key note address on the topic Elder Abuse. In absence of Chief Guest, Dr. M. Ravi, IPS, Mr. SP. Ambrose, released our special publication entitled "Sweet 19" and distributed Financial assistance to poor students. Tests for BMI, BP and Random Blood Sugar were done for all participants done at no cost.

- 3.3 EC Meetings were held regularly every month. Core group meetings were held frequently to plan and carry out the activities.
- **4.0 World Elders Day** was observed jointly with Ethiraj College for Women from 9.30 a.m. to 12.30. p.m. on October 4, 2014 at Ethiraj College Chennai 8. His Excellency Dr. K. Rosiah, Governor of Tamil Nadu was the Chief Guest. SCB Awards of Excellence were presented to Mr. S. P. Ambrose, Dr. T.S. Kanaka, CN. Prasad and NSS student Selvi A. Mareeswari. Earlier, pledge against Elder Abuse was administered by the Chairman to the students and other

participants. Thiru V.M. Muralidharan, Chairman, Ethiraj College Trust, M/s. Dr. V.S. Natarajan, Mr. T.V. Hariharan, T.C. Dayalan, Dr. K. Manimekalai, Dr. R. Rajalakshmi and Dr. P. Padmini, were honored. Cultural Programme was held by the Students of Ethiraj College. The detailed report was published in November 2014 issue of LinkAge.

- **5.0 Elder Welfare Programmes**: The Bureau has conducted 170 programmes up to March 2015 since inception. During 2014 2015, 14 programmes were held as per Annexure 1 & 2.
- **6.0** I want to highlight the other important events held in 2014 -15 as given below:
- 6.1 A unique interactive meet on Safety & Security of Senior Citizens with TN Police at F3 Nungambakkam police Station, was held on 20.12.14. (Please refer January 2015 issues of Link Age).
- 6.2 A Mega Health Camp on Comprehensive Geriatric Health Assessment at Madras Medical College, was held on 24.01.14. (Please refer LinkAge, February 2015 issue).
- 6.3 One Day Outing to Thiruvallur was held on 21.02.15. (Please refer LinkAge, March 2015 issue)
- **7.0 Finance:**The Bureau is carrying its activities in promoting Elder Welfare and Elder Health Care with the contribution / subscriptions of members and donations from well wishers / organisations. The audited Balance Sheet is placed separately, vide Annexure 3.



Court rescues Senior Citizen and asks son to vacate house

A city court in New Delhi has come to the aid of an aged man, who was being harassed by his son for wishing to give a share of property to his daughters too, and asked the son to vacate the father's house. 'Life is not a ladder but a wheel which takes a full circle,"Additional District Judge Kamini Lau said in her judgment, adding that the judiciary would step in to stop inappropriate and illegal conduct"of children against aged parents and that too when the parents needed them the most. The judge held that 73-year-old Ganga Saran Tripathi was the owner of a property in North Delhi's Burari and had absolute right to deal with it the way he wanted. His son Arvind Tripathi and daughter-in -law BinduTripathiwere"only permissive users or licensees"in respect of the property and due to their misbehavior and misconduct with their father, their license to stay in it had been "validly terminated" as the old man had disowned them, she said. "Hence, I told that plaintiff Ganga Saran Tripathi is entitled to the relief of possession and permanent injunction in respect of the suit propert.., "the judge said. The court granted three months to the son and his wife to vacate the property and hand it over to their father, and directed them not to sell or transfer it to anyone. Ganga had moved the court alleging that he was being abused, rebuked and humiliated by his son and daughter - in - law for his refusal to transfer his property in their names.

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
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
