ஊழியர்களும், தொண்டு நிறுவன பொறுப்பாளர்களும் கூட அவமதிப்பும் அவதூறும் செய்கிறார்கள். இருந்தாலும் அய்க்கிய நாடகள் அவை இதை வலியுறுத்தி இந்நாளுக்காக கருப்பொருளையும் முன் வைக்கிறது. அதன்படி ்'முதியோர் இவ்வாண்டுக்கான கருப்பொருள்தான் ' அவமதிப்பு ஒழிய ஒவ்வொரு நாடும் ஒருங்கிணைந்து ஏகமனதாக உறுதியான நடவடிக்கையில் **ஈடுபடவேண்டும்''**. இதில் அரசாங்கம் முனைப்பு காட்டாவிட்டால், குடும்பத்திலும், சமுதாயத்திலும், அரசு அமைப்புகளிலும், வாய்மொழி மூலமாக, சைகை முகபாவனை மூலமாக, அடி உதை பலாத்காரம் மூலமாக, உள ரீதியாக, பொருளாதார ரீதியாக, சமூக ரீதியாக அன்றாடம் நடைபெறும் அவமரியாதை மற்றும் தீங்கை எப்படி ஒழிக்க முடியும்? கொள்கைகளையும், சட்டங்களையும் தவறாது உறுதியாக அமுல் செய்ய வேண்டும். முதியோர்கள் அன்புடனும் ஆதரவுடனும் கண்ணியத்துடனும் பராமரிக்கப்படும் சமுதாயம் தான் மகிழ்ச்சியான, வளமான, ஒளிர் விடும் சமுதாயம்.

So we need one focused action from every family to each limb of Govt. nation wise against elder abuse. The society with utmost love, respect and dignity to older persons is considered a true prosperous and peaceful society. State must implement the Policy Acts and Rules strictly in full, observe World Elder Abuse Awareness Day and International Day of Older Persons.

Report on Activities

Senior Citizens Bureau - 162nd Program - "HYCARE CENTRE" - 20.07.2014



Our bureau in association with HYCARE CENTRE at Aysha hospitals kilpauk conducted a programme on diabetic foot and wounds. Prakash lulla welcomed the guests and members. Chairman Dr. M. Singaraja introduced the guests to the audience. He condoled the passing away of Mrs. Murugian spouse of our former VC & Sec. Gen. He very emotionally recalled the services of Mr Murgaian to the bureau and wished gods best blessing be with the family at this sad time. He also condoled the sad plane disaster over UKRAINE, and the sad collapase of the skyscraper at Chennai. He honoured the guest speakers Dr. Prof. V.B. Narayanamurthy and Dr. Rajesh. Dr. Narayanamurthy a plastic, diabetic foot surgeon took pains to bring forward the problem of Diabetic Mellitus patients who developed Neuropathy-loss of sensation in foot, which leads to ulcer and spreading into damaging the skin, bone, and the area around, most patients feel that this is a non solvable problem, but the professor cautioned that now good investigative process has brought about treatment in bringing normal blood supply to the area, and proper nerve sensitivity also back. Thus healing is easily possible and safe if the wound is not properly diagnosied or treated early the foot gets severly infected in causing at times removal of the infected foot. Hence with new treatments, and blood supply normal sensitivity can be restored and patient gets normal comfort. He stressed the importance of foot care, and hygene specially the diabetic patients.

Dr. Rajesh Kesavan orthopaedic and foot surgeon said that every 7 seconds we have lost the life of a diabetic and every 17 seconds a diabetic patient is diagonised Neuropathy and lack of sensitivity leads to deformity, ulceration, and most deaths occur due to poor medication and wrong myths. foot and skin wounds that are not treated in time cause fissures, and damage to bone structure, and deeper infections leading to ampitations and lossof limb. He took great



pains to stress the need to protect the diabetic foot properly at all time by wearing protective shoes that cover the front toes fully and also the heels fully, not wearing high heels or hawai chappals, washing the feet after coming back and drying the inner feet and and fingers, wearing PROPER FOOTWEAR EVEN AT HOME not applying balms, and oils to open wounds, keeping the feet dry and moisturised at all times sometimes the use of coconut oil as a moisturiser has attracted mice and insects to the neuropatic foot, this can be avoided. Vasilene or parfin wax can be used instead.He also stressed the need for immidate treatment in time of accident, or wound occurance.the question an d answer session was lively and informative. Both the doctors took great pains in demystifying that diabetic foot was incurable and long standing. Mr. S. Jayakumar Secretary General proposed the vote of thanks. Useful and informative programme ended.

EC Meeting was held at 12-30 P.M. on 20th July immediately after our monthly meeting held at Hycare Centre, Ayisha Hospital Kilpauk Capt.Dr.M.Singaraja presided over and welcomed the members.
