### Government of India Ministry of Corporate Affairs

### **Notification**

New Delhi, dated the 17th, February 2014

- G.S.R.\_\_\_\_(E). In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (I) of section 467 of the Companies Act, 2013 (18 of 2013), the Central Government hereby makes the following amendments of Schedule VII of the said Act, namely:
- (1) In Schedule VII, for items (i) to (x) and the entries relating thereto, the following items and entries shall be substituted, namely:-
- "(i) eradicating hunger, poverty and malnutrition, promoting preventive health care and sanitation and making available safe drinking water;
- (ii) promoting education, including special education and employment enhancing vocation skills especially among children, women, elderly, and the differently abled and livelihood enhancement projects;
- (iv) ensuring environmental sustainability, ecological balance, protection of flora and fauna, animal welfare, agroforestry, conservation of natural resources and maintaining quality of soil, air and water,

- (v) protection of national heritage, art and culture including restoration of buildings and sites of historical importance and works of art; setting up public libraries; promotion and development of traditional arts and handicrafts;
- (vi) measures for the benefit of armed forces veterans, war widows and their dependents;
- (vii) training to promote rural sports, nationally recognised sports, paralympic sports and Olympic sports;
- (viii) contribution to the Prime Minister's National Relief Fund or any other fund set up by the Central Government for socio-economic development and relief and welafe of the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, other backward classes, minorities and women;
- (ix) contributions or funds provided to technology located within academic institutions which are approved by the Central Governmenet;
  - (x) rural development projects".
- 2. This notification shall come into force with effect 1st April, 2014.

## Recommendations of the Parliamentary Standing Committee

A parliamentary committee has recommended that retirement age should be increased from 60 years to 65 years, citing the increase in ageing population and their productivity.

In its report tabled in Lok Sabha today, the committee also advocated a host of benefits to the geriatric population, including upping their income tax exemption limit and setting up of super-speciality hospitals in all states exclusively for them. The committee would like the Ministry (Social Justice and Empowerment) to seriously consider the various options which would include reviewing the age of retirement, re-employment opportunities for the retired persons... and setting up a Directorate of Employment and Rehabilitation for Senior Citizens," it said. It asked the government to look at the continuity of employment up to 65 years of age. The Standing Committee headed by Hemanand Biswal noted that the population of senior citizens is expected to rise to 12.4 per cent by 2026 against 7.5 per cent in 2001 and the numbers of those above 60 and 80 years of age would see a whopping increase of 326 per cent and 700 per cent respectively by 2050. The senior citizens should get a pension of at least Rs 1,000 per month, it said, adding that the criteria for it may be universalised for all non-income tax payers. It has also reiterated its earlier recommendation that old-age homes be set up in all districts of the country. It has urged the Finance Ministry to periodically raise income tax exemption keeping in view the increasing cost of living and prohibitive cost of healthcare for senior citizens. The committee also recommended that the government should try to adopt best practices from the Scandinavian countries, which are noted for their welfare facilities for the elderly population.

### **CARDIAC HEALTH**



A special programme on "CARDIAC HEALTH" was held on Sunday 16 -02-2014 at the Kauvery Hospital Chennai- 18. Prakash H Lulla welcomes the chief guest Shri Dr. K. G. Sundar Kumar and Dr Lakshmipathy Ramesh and Members of the SCB. There seemed camaraderie and love and gratitude after the valentine day's celebrations. Dr. K. G. Sundar kumar, Senior Consultant Cardiology Kauvery Hospital very simply explained that the heart is a pumping organ. Impure blood from all parts of the body brought into heart on it right side i.e. into right auricle. From right auricle blood enters the right ventricle through valves. Purified blood from lungs brought back into heart on its right side i.e.Left auricle. From left auricle blood enters the left ventricle through values. The values allow the blood to pass on one direction only it does not allow the blood flow backward. From the left ventricle of the heart blood is pumped up to all parts of the body through aorta. In case if valves are damaged they can be changed. In case if obstruction in the artery tubes due to fatty deposits and pressure these were cleared by primary angioplasty. These obstructions could cause fatigue, sweating dispenses, chest pain and vomiting. Due to high cholesterol levels and bad life styles. Alcohol and stress also being factors. In India these problems were 4 times greater than the west. He advised to keep the BP at 140/90 and range sugar levels at 110(fast) 140 (2hrs) and HDL at 40 and LDL below100 levels. In case being diagnosed as diabetic or hypertension to take medication daily and not to stop at all without medical advice. He advised not to take fatty, unsaturated foods as age advances simple regimen of walking briskly for 45 minutes at least 5 to 6 days week should be



adequate. One should have a positive outlook and meditate to reduce stress levels. He advised that at least 6 to 7 hrs of good sleep at night is needed. Dr. Sundar kumars brotherly simple way of coming across was the need of the hour and he's greatly appreciated as the angel of god. Prakaash H Lulla, LakshmiNarayaan, Pannerselvam, Dr. Nirmala, Poonthalir helped in the arrangements. Dr. P. S. Rajam once again provided with packed lunch to members. The next programme on the topic, "FALLS" will be on 23march 2014 Sunday at 10.30 at Kauvery Hospital by Dr.Lakshmipathy Ramesh.
