Presented by on Oct 4, 2014, during Commemoration of IDOP and release of the book "Voice of the Veteran"

Revered Chief Guest, Respected Dignitaries on the dais, off the dais, Loveable office bearers of Probus and other Senior Citizens Forums, Fellow Senior Citizens, Dear Junior Citizens and friends from Media,

Today is a red letter day in the annals of Senior Citizens Bureau. We are honoured and privileged to have His Excellency The Governor of Tamil Nadu as the Chief Guest, to commemorate 24th International Day of Older Persons (IDOP), partnering with NSS, Ethiraj College for Women. The commitment of Ethiraj College to promote Inter-generation bonding and Social Development, lead by Thiru VM. Muralidharan, Trust Chairman, is commendable.

The Commemoration of first IDOP was held on October 1, 1991.
